

Five New Hotels Planned For Central Indiana

Three Indianapolis-based companies have confirmed their plans to build a total of five new hotels in Indianapolis and Plainfield. Three hotels being planned by Schahet Hotels and General Hotels are expected to break ground this fall at Ameriplex, a business and industrial park near the Indianapolis International Airport.

Schahet Hotels Chairman Gary Schahet tells Inside INdiana Business that the area near the airport is prime for two new hotels, a 126-room Hilton Garden Inn and a 119-room Hampton Inn & Suites. He says with the expansion of the airport and the Indiana Convention Center demand is increasing for hotel space.

General Hotels Chief Executive Officer Jim Dora Jr. says his company plans to break ground late this fall on a 150-room Embassy Suites Hotel just off of Six Points Rd., south of Interstate 70 near the airport.

Premier Properties USA is partnering with Interstate Hotels & Resorts to build two aloft Hotels, one at The Metropolis lifestyle center in Plainfield and the other at The Venu, a mixed-use development planned for the Indianapolis northside at 86th St. and Keystone Ave.
